

# TEQUILAS

## Blanco/Plata

*Blanco or plata (silver) tequila is generally unaged and bottled right after distillation, but it may be aged for two months, or less in stainless tanks or neutral oak barrels before bottling.*

Earthy, citrusy and herbal.	
<b>Cabo Wabo</b> .....	12

Cazadores means “hunter,” so named for the stags that used to roam the agave fields in the Jalisco Highlands.	
<b>Chinaco - Tamaulipas</b> .....	13
First tequila distillery outside of Jalisco. <i>Pronounced minerality, and striking salinity.</i>	
<b>Corazon - Los Altos, Highlands</b> .....	8
<i>Sweet and oily, black pepper and asparagus.</i>	
<b>Don Julio - Highlands</b> .....	14
<i>Lemon, grapefruit, black pepper.</i>	
<b>Dulce Vida - Los Altos, Highlands</b> .....	12
100% organic, 100 proof tequila, made in a sustainable facility.	
<b>El Jimador - well</b> .....	8
The best selling Tequila in Mexico. <i>Fresh, lively, citrusy.</i>	
<b>Espolon - Los Altos, Highlands</b> .....	9
<i>Floral, tropical, peppery.</i>	
<b>Fortaleza - Lowlands</b> .....	13
<i>Dried berries, cardamom, citrus.</i>	
<b>Herradura - Lowlands</b> .....	12
Citrus notes from fruit trees on the property.

<b>Partida - Lowlands</b> .....	12
<i>Softly floral, fresh citrus, tropical fruits.</i>	

## Reposado

*Reposado tequila is aged for more than two months but less than one year in oak barrels of any size. Reposado is considered by many tequila connoisseurs to be the most compelling expression of tequila.*

Briny and woody like a single-malt Scotch, slight green tea and mint, vanilla.

<i>Stone fruit, nuts, caramel apples.</i>	
<b>El Jimador - well</b> .....	8
<i>Buttery, almond, vanilla and spice.</i>	
<b>El Tesoro - Los Altos, Highlands</b> .....	15
<i>Mellow wood, mustard seed, dill, candied almonds.</i>	
<b>Espolon - Highlands</b> .....	9
<i>Brown spices, caramel, fudge.</i>

<i>Honey, lemon butter, figs, baking spices.</i>	
<b>Gran Centenario - Highlands</b> .....	9
The best of the Gran Centenario line-up, aged in new French oak.	
<b>Gran Centenario Rosangel</b> .....	10
A reposado tequila aged in used port barrels and infused with hibiscus.	
<b>Herradura - Lowlands</b> .....	14
This is widely believed to be the first reposado tequila introduced to the world.	
<b>Herradura Double Barrel Reposado - Lowlands</b> .....	14
After its initial 11 months of aging, this tequila spends another month in a brand new toasted oak barrel. This barrel was chosen exclusively for Superica. <i>Vanilla, caramel, orange zest, cooked agave.</i>	
<b>Jose Cuervo Tradicional</b> .....	9
This limited production tequila spends 2 to 6 months in white oak.	
<b>Ocho, “La Magueyera” 2014 - Lowlands</b> .....	15
From the same estate and vintage as the Plata but aged 2 months.	
<b>Partida - Lowlands</b> .....	14
<i>Honey, hazelnut, saw dust, almond.</i>	
<b>Puro Verde - Lowlands</b> .....	10
<i>Oily texture, praline, citrus, ripe berry.</i>	
<b>Sparkle Donkey</b> .....	8
Aged for 8 months in used bourbon barrels.	

To be considered tequila, a spirit must be made from only Blue Weber Agave, and only in Mexico. Tequila’s expense comes from the length of time required before harvesting a mature agave (7 to 10 years), as well as the artisanal production methods. Tequilas from the highlands of Jalisco tend to be fruitier and sweeter, while tequilas from the lowlands are often earthier. All tequilas listed are 100% agave.

# AÑEJO

*Añejo tequilas are aged for at least one year but less than three years in small oak barrels, often single-use whiskey barrels from the U.S. or Canada.*

<i>Rich but not sweet. Soft vanilla, buttery, floral, fruity agave.</i>	
<b>Herradura - Lowlands</b> .....	15
<i>Aged for 2 years. Nutty, toasted oak, dried fruit.</i>	
<b>Milagro - Highlands</b> .....	12
<i>Aged 18 months. Caramel, coconut, tobacco and banana.</i>	
<b>Ocho, "El Refugio" 2012 - Highlands</b> .....	17
<i>Toffee, tangerine, white pepper, clove, green olive.</i>	
<b>Partida - Lowlands</b> .....	16
<i>Aged for 18 months in used Jack Daniels barrels. Cherry, almond, dried fruit, banana.</i>	
<b>Tres Generaciones</b> .....	16
<i>A whiskey drinker's tequila. Brown sugar, salt water taffy, vanilla extract, toasty oak.</i>	

# EXTRA AÑEJO

*Extra Añejo was added as a tequila category in 2006. These tequilas must be aged for a minimum of three years in oak barrels.*

<i>Single-estate tequila aged for 40 months. Creamy texture, vanilla, black pepper, chewy agave, citrus forward.</i>	
<b>Jose Cuervo Reserva de la Familia</b> .....	35
<i>This was the world's first Extra Añejo tequila.</i>	



# MEZCAL

*Most mezcal is hand-crafted by small producers, using very traditional methods. The piñas are roasted underground, in pit ovens over hot rocks. This is where mezcal gets its distinctive smoky flavor. The juice is fermented in clay or copper pots, which also adds to the rustic flavor.*

<i>All estate agave espadin, organic and biodynamic.</i>	
<b>Fidencio Joven Pechuga - Santiago Metatlán</b> .....	25
<i>Pechuga sees a third distillation in the presence of quince, apples, bananas, pineapples and guava...and a chicken breast!</i>	
<b>Illegal Reposado</b> .....	16
<i>Clove, toffee, caramelized pear.</i>	
<b>Mezcalero No. 8 - Santa Maria la Pila</b> .....	18
<i>Made in 2013 from wild agaves. Only 1080 bottles produced.</i>	
<b>Scorpion Añejo</b> .....	13
<i>A smooth but smoky mezcal with a scorpion in every bottle. Leather, tobacco, oil, lime and mint.</i>	
<b>Sombra Joven</b> .....	10
<i>Jalapeño, tomato, pepper spice.</i>
